"My Dad retired in 2010 and my Mom in 2012. Financially, they were not prepared for retirement. My Dad receives pension and they both receive social security income, but not enough to maintain the lifestyle they had when working full time. Ultimately, this led to them turning to credit cards and other forms of financing to pay their bills. Each month they struggled and I saw the stress start to build and the weight become heavier on their shoulders until the next check arrived. Finally, I decided I had to help.

We reviewed their finances and discovered a mortgage, an equity line, two cars, 7+ credit cards, installment loans...a LOT. We explained a cash-out refinance and how with their equity we could eliminate some of their bills—freeing up cash and eliminating the use of credit cards. It sounded so good to them that I don't think they believed us.

- 1) Don't throw away your overripe fruit! Instead, hang sliced fruit from a tree or add to a suet bird feeder for butterflies to eat! They love sliced oranges, grapefruit, strawberries, peaches, nectarines, apples and bananas.




