- species found on every continent except Antarctica.
- Dutterfly wings move in a figure "8" motion.

Can My Mortgage Payment Change?

hile your Principal and Interest payment will not change if you have a fixed rate mortgage, your Taxes and Insurance can adjust. Each year we

do an escrow analysis on the customers we service. This often causes the borrower's monthly mortgage payment to change based on increases in homeowners' insurance (HOI) and property taxes. Each state is assigned a certain month for an escrow analysis:

January – Alabama, Kentucky, North Carolina, Georgia February – South Carolina, Texas

March - Michigan, West Virginia

April – Washington DC

May - Indiana, Massachusetts

August - Connecticut, Ohio

October – Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island December – Florida, Virginia, New Hampshire

The escrow analysis causes a higher level of anxiety recently because property taxes and HOI increases have been larger than normal. HOI in many areas has gone through the roof. In Florida for example, there has been a 68% increase in premiums! If HOI was \$1,000 per year, that means it is now \$1,680. That \$83 per month HOI added to a mortgage payment has now become \$140, causing the borrower's payment to increase by \$57.

Check the website of your state's treasury or revenue department for details about your tax increase and see if you are eligible for a property tax relief program. If your HOI is the source of your escrow account adjustment, contact your insurance provider and explore options for lowering your premium.

Grow a Wellness Garden
